

Accessible traffic light cards

These cards are to help people with and without a learning disability make virtual meetings more accessible.

Ideally they should be printed and held up by a person on a video call. If you do not have access to a printer, please speak to your line manager for support.

When should they be used:

I don't understand – if someone is using jargon or complicated words that are not accessible. Sometimes complicated words have to be used, if so please try to explain simply what they mean.

Speak clearly and slowly – if someone is talking too quickly or their volume isn't right.

That's good –when you agree or think something is a good idea.
