





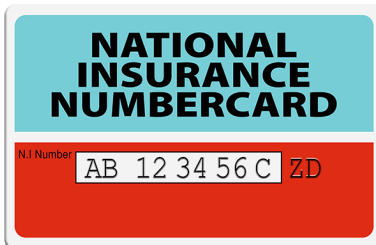
# Registering to vote

## Information that you need to register to vote

You will be asked:



- Which part of the UK do you live in, or do you live in another country?
- What is your nationality?
- What is your date of birth?
- What is your full name?
- Have you ever changed your name?
- What is your national insurance number?
- What is your address?
- Do you live at a second address?
- Do you want your name and address to appear publicly on the electoral register? This means that a charity or business can see your information and could use it to contact you or to try and sell you things. You'll still be able to vote if you say 'no' to this.

Things to remember:

1. You need to register to vote every time you move home
2. You need to register to vote again if you change your name or surname
